Notice to Exhibitors

OVERNIGHT PARKING will be permitted in the parking lot Friday and Saturday night, but no hook-ups or facilities are available.

SMACCM, its members and CCSC assume no responsibility for loss, theft, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor, handler, or any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

EXHIBITORS should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

NO ENTRY FEE WILL BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

NO ENTRY FEE WILL BE REFUNDED if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause which is beyond the control of the Club or the Trial Secretary.

Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Obedience and Rally Trials, the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a veterinarian of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed or postmarked before the trial commences.

The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per trial for injured dogs. Written request for a refund must be made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first trial day and a veterinarian's letter must be provided within one week of the trial.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Exhibitors are responsible for being ready for judging when called to the ring. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. SMACCM has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

ALL CELL PHONES must be turned OFF when in the show building except the emergency cell phone located at the secretary's table, 573-228-4738 or 573-268-5548.

SMACCM DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring. Warm-up must be done on lead.

Dogs under 6 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC events.

NO SMOKING is permitted on CCSC property per Columbia ordinance. Exhibitors may smoke in their cars as long as they also extinguish all smoking materials in their cars.

Rally will be judged in a 50' x 50' ring.

There will be NO food service available at the trial site.

Rally Trial #2 will begin 30 minutes following the conclusion of Rally Trial #1.

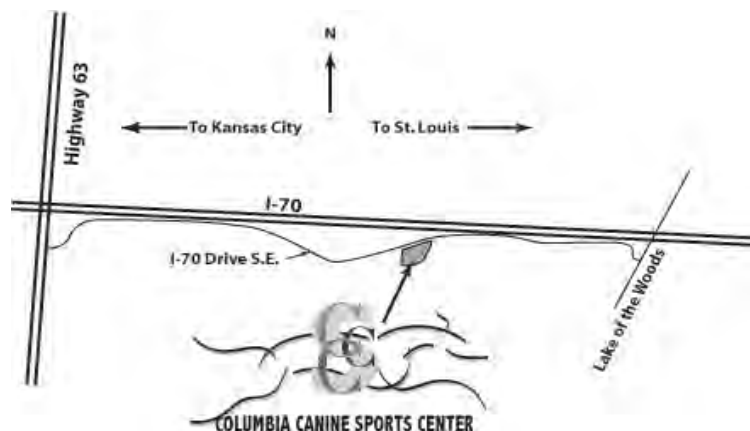
