No hand-delivered entries can be accepted in the first 24 hours.

All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms, one dog per entry form.

Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC Agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable.

Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed.

Obstacles and Equipment

Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

The equipment for this event is provided Purina Event Center. The trial will include an ISC broad jump, wall jump and double jump, and 4' bars.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES (ISC):

Purpose: The international sweepstakes class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various international style Standard and Jumpers With Weaves courses. The rules for This class are generally based on international rules. The variety in international agility Course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge Of The Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in excellent / master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC website (<http://www.akc.org>).

Eligibility: ISC classes are open to dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials. There is no Preferred Option for ISC; dogs may enter at their preferred jump height, however they will be scored against the regular division dogs jumping the same jump height.

Jump heights: Dogs may be entered in their regular jump heights, however, only those dogs running in the 12" & 16" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC Cutoffs) or any dog entering the 24" jump height will be eligible for the direct invitation to World Team Tryouts. Please review the 2026 EO and AWC tryouts rules for further details. The FCI/ISC cutoffs for those heights are as follows:

- 12" - Small team – shoulder height = 13 3/4" or less
- 16" - Medium team – shoulder height = 16 7/8" or less
- 20" - Intermediate team – shoulder height = 18 7/8" or less
- 24" - Large team – shoulder height = greater than 18 7/8"

Jump Height Information

All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge of record, except 24"/24C" dogs. If a VMO or an AKC Representative is available, all dogs without height cards, including 24"/24C" dogs, will need to be measured. When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dogs on the Dogs To Be Measured List.

Jump Heights: DOGS MAY BE ENTERED IN THEIR REGULAR AKC JUMP HEIGHTS, HOWEVER, only those dogs running in the 12", 16", 20" and 24" classes that also meet the FCI/ISC measuring cut off (please see below) may use their clean run toward the required qualification for entering WTT or EOTT. Please review the 2026 EO and AWC tryouts rules for further details.

MEASURING AND JUMP HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division *lower* than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

On the entry form, please designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs to Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during the day of show check-in. However, it is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. **Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.**

Classes Offered

ISC STD and ISC JWW will be offered according to the entry form. (International Sweepstakes Classes will be offered when indicated in the premium and on the entry form). A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC web site. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class.** The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es).

Notice to Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
- ESSFTA may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per day for injured or ill dogs. Written request for a refund must be made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first trial day and a veterinarian's letter must be provided within one week of the trial.
- The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per day in the form of a club voucher for exhibitors who are absent due to a death in the immediate family.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. ESSFTA has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.
- Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must enter their JH# and complete back of form. All owners of mixed breed dogs must first obtain an AKC Canine Partners listing number before they may enter an AKC Agility event. The dog's breed name should be entered as "All American Dog". The dog's listing number must be entered on the entry form and "AKC No." checked.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- ESSFTA does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee. -- No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$12. Checks for canceled entries will be shredded.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

 NO SMOKING or VAPING is allowed in the building.
 Dogs may not be left in the building overnight.
 No outside food or beverages (including alcohol) may be brought into the Event Center.
 No lazer pens or flexi-leads are allowed in the building.
 There will not be a VMO at the trial.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/ Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on the course when the dog's obstacle performance is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)

**** OFFERED AT THIS TRIAL ****

For Exhibition Only allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is offered in all ISC classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying. FEO runs are treated as trial entries, and must be entered, paid and recorded as such. The handler must declare FEO the day of the trial/at the time of the run. Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the startline. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed. The exhibitor must declare FEO to the scribe and judge when entering the ring, prior to leading out.

"After Closing" Waiting List

A waiting list (30 run maximum each day) will be maintained for these trials once they have closed on June 29. The waiting list will be active until its deadline — Monday, July 6, 6:00 pm CT. Any runs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by runs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. **If a run cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the run.** Entry fees for runs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full.

GIRLS IN SEASON

BIS are allowed to run

- BIS will run in their regular order.
- BIS will be required to bring a mat or piece of carpet for their dog to be placed on at the start line of their run.
 BIS will be required to wear pants in the building (except in the ring and just prior to their run).
- Owners of BIS should be respectful of others in regards to crating, pottyng, hanging out.

From West: Take I-70 to Hwy 47, Exit 193. Take Hwy 47 south to Hwy 100. Continue on 100 to I-44 east. Take I-44 east one exit to Gray Summit. Follow directions above.
