Class Order - Regular and Preferred will be run together at each height.

Friday FAST*** – M/X STD – T2B – M/X JWW

Saturday Premier JWW – M/X JWW – Open JWW – Novice JWW – M/X STD – Open STD – Novice STD

Sunday Premier STD – M/X STD – Open STD – Novice STD – M/X JWW – Open JWW – Novice JWW

***FAST will run all levels together by height, two walkthroughs then run all.

Walkthrough Schedule

FAST - All classes will run together by jump height: 1st walk 24-20", 2nd walk 16-4", then run all.

T2B - Two walkthroughs: 1st walk 24-20", 2nd walk 16-4", then run all.

Master/Excellent Standard and JWW classes:

- Friday & Sunday 24-20" will walk then run ; 16-4" will have two walkthroughs then run, 1st walk 16", 2nd walk 12-4".
- Saturday 4-16" will have two walkthroughs then run, 1st walk 4-12", 2nd walk 16" ; 20-24" will walk then run.

Saturday Premier JWW - Two walkthroughs 4-16" walk then 20-24" walk, then all will run.

Sunday Premier STD - Two walkthroughs 24-20" walk then 16-4" walk, then all will run.

Routes to the Show Site

From the West: I-70 East to Exit 208. Turn right at the end of the ramp, then immediately right again onto the South Service Road. Turn Left on Swantnerville Dr. (0.5 mile, at First Bank Sign). WestInn Kennel is 500 feet down on the left.

From the East: I-70 West to Exit 208. Turn left at the end of the ramp, then cross bridge and at light turn right onto the South Service Road. Turn Left on Swantnerville Dr. (0.5 mile, at First Bank Sign). WestInn Kennel is 500 feet down on the left.

"After Closing" Waiting List

The waiting list will be active until Monday, June 29, 2025 at 6:00 pm CT . Any runs that are pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by runs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. If a run is pulled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the runs. Entry fees for dogs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full.

No printed course copies will be distributed. Course maps will be posted inside the building. Course maps will also be posted at www.gsdsecretaryservice.com the morning before each trial. The running order, judge's briefing, trial chair briefing and results will also be posted at this site.

Self-service ribbons and awards after the completion of the class.

Dogs may not be left in the building overnight.

Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

The building is climate-controlled.

Please bring chairs, crates and water for your dogs, and clean up supplies.

Westinn Turf Fines – Handlers are responsible for the following fines if your dog has an accident on the turf: \$20 for urination; \$30 for defecation; \$50 for loose stool or vomiting

Move-ups

For the Friday trial: MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CT, Monday, June 29

Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent.

For the Saturday and Sunday trials: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on Friday and Saturday, respectively and must be submitted at the trial.

Change of Entry

As described in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a dog which is entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible may be moved to Novice B. In addition, if notification has been received in writing from the AKC after closing that a dog is not eligible for a class entered, the dog may be moved to the correct class. The request for the move must be made at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

AKC Height Cards

There will NOT be a VMO at the trial.

There will NOT be a VMO at this trial. However, if your dog is under 2 years old and has never been measured, or if your dog is over 2 years old and you do not have at least one official measurement, you need to have your dog measured before your first run.

Food

Coffee, breakfast breads and fruit will be provided each morning.

Water and snacks (crackers, chips, popcorn, cookies) will be available for everyone.

Lunch food orders will be taken for food delivery on all three days from a local restaurant. Show Me Bucks can be used toward your lunch purchase

You may bring your own food and drinks. There are also many restaurants within minutes of the trial site.

Crating/Setup Information

Thursday, July 2 setup for exhibitors is between 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm.

No mats are to be placed under crates at Westinn.

Please do not save crating space for others with tarps or mats. If you want to save a space for someone, please set up a crate in their area. This ensures we don't waste any space. Thank you!

Chairs will be set next to crates to keep aisles clear.

Those crating in the front row could help ensure extra crating space for others by placing their chairs in front of their crate in the spectator chair row.

Thank you for not using a "tent type" crate unless housing more than one dog in it as tent crates take up more space than a regular crate.

If you set up a table over your crating space, please make sure it does not take up more width than your dog's crate.

Trial hours on Friday is 7:30 am to 30 minutes after completion.

Trial hours on Saturday and Sunday are 7:00 am to 30 minutes after completion.

Motel & RV Information

All exhibitors must be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on the motel, RV and trial grounds. Motels require that dogs be crated when unattended. Any damages to motels, RV sites or the trial site can result in disciplinary action by the Event Committee. It is expected that exhibitors will clean up immediately after their own dogs and strongly encourage others to do the same.

All owners/exhibitors should be aware that the entire motel grounds and RV sites are considered within the trial grounds. You will be responsible for all damage to your room/site and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the grounds will be brought to the attention of the trial-giving club and its Event Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the motel or RV facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

Show Me Agility Club of Central Missouri may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or postmarked before judging commences.

The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per day for injured or ill dogs in the form of a club voucher. Written request for a refund must be made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first trial day and a veterinarian's letter must be provided within one week of the trial.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Westinn Kennel has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must complete back of form.

All owners of mixed breed dogs must first obtain an AKC Canine Partners listing number before they may enter an AKC Agility event. Dogs entered must list the breed name as "All American Dog". The dog's listing number must be entered on the entry form and "AKC No." checked.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Show Me Agility Club of Central Missouri does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee. No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$12.

Checks for canceled entries will be shredded — no checks will be returned.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

For Exhibition only (FEO)

FEO Will be offered at this trial in all classes

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow Exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the Entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. **Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.**
- The Exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.
- Course time for FEO in T2B, JWW, Standard, Premier, and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST course times for each class/height are as noted in the regulations. **Exhibitors must exit the ring when the horn sounds.** FEO runs will scored as 'absent' in catalog and results.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run. Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on the course when the dog's obstacle performance is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score.

Moves to a Higher/Lower/Lateral class

A move is defined as moving from one level to another within the same class, or moving laterally from Regular to Preferred (or vice versa) in a class. For the Friday trial: Moves close at 6:00 pm CT, Monday, June 29. Moves may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, email confirmation of the move will be sent. For the Saturday and Sunday trials: Moves close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on Friday and Saturday respectively and must be submitted at the trial. All mailed/emailed moves close at 6:00 pm CT, Monday, June 29.

Prizes and Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to First Place through Fourth Place in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement rosettes.

1st place	Blue
2nd place	Red
3rd place	Yellow
4th place	White
Qualifying	Green

An AGCH rosette will be awarded to any dog finishing an AGCH title at these trials. A MACH rosette and bar will be awarded to any dog finishing a MACH title at these trials. A PACH rosette and bar will be awarded to any dog finishing a PACH title at these trials. A PAX rosette will be awarded to any dog finishing a PAX title at these trials. A new title ribbon will be awarded to any dog finishing a title at these trials. Dogs qualifying in both Master Standard and Master JWW at the same trial will receive a "Double-Q" award (value less than \$1).
